First Step:

Interested candidates are required to register themselves on the JCJTF website, Registration will be opened in the month of February. Eligibility criteria for candidates:

- 1) Candidate must have an LL.B. Degree (3-year or 5-year). Candidates who are currently in their final year of the graduation are also eligible.
- 2) A candidate must have attained the age of 21 years at the time of admission in the JCJTF INDORE centre.

Second Step:

Written Examination

Registered candidates will be called for written examination which will be conducted at the Indore JCJTF centre.

A written examination will have two papers. First one is general studies paper. This paper will be objective type with multiple choice questions. Second paper will be subjective type written examination.
